- 1. Two divisions. Eight people in division one. Six people in division two.
- Division One (All play all. Best of three matches)
 Division Two (All play all, TWICE. Single matches).
- 3. Matches are to be played over the season on four dates around the country.
- 4. All results will be kept up to date on the CAI web site throughout the season.
- 5. Top two from Division One play-off for the Irish Masters title and the "Cyril Corbally" trophy (Best of 3).
- 6. Top two from Division Two play-off for automatic promotion, the Division Two title and the "Herbert Corbally" trophy (Single game).
- 7. Bottom player from Division 1 is automatically relegated.
- 8. The players finishing 2^{nd} and 3^{rd} in Division 2 play off against the players finishing 2^{nd} and 3^{rd} last from Division 1. (Finals day, Best of 3)
- 9. If players are not available on particular designated dates, the assigned matches must be played <u>before the scheduled date</u>, **at a mutually agreed venue**. These matches must be played in their entirety and not at several attempts. The results of these matches must be telephoned, text or emailed to the manager immediately after the match.
- 10. Time limits: Division 1 (6hrs per mate

Venue Manager Responsibilities:

- Collection of entry fee on first days play.
 (€20 Adults, €10 Students) Special Reduced Fee for 2009.
- 2. Reminder calls to participants 2-3 days prior to each weekend of play.
- 3. Contact the hosting club to ensure they are ready for the event. (lawns cut etc.)
- 4. Ensure hoops are firm and set satisfactorily prior to start of play.
- 5. Ensure matches are started on time.
- 6. Ensure the availability of lunches. (There is no set lunch time for players, take it when you get the opportunity)
- 7. Record scores and send to event manager at close of play each day.

(All payers are expected to referee themselves IF no qualified referees are at the venues of play)

Final league standings will be decided as follows:

1) Matches won

2) Who beat whom (Where 3 are tied, if 1 player has lost to both others they are

- eliminated from the process)
- 3) Games won
- 4) Triple peel (or greater) turns completed in a game won.
- 5) Net points
- 6) Toss of a coin
